Question and Answer

November 25, 2019:

- Q1. Given the complexity and multi-discipline nature of the project, will multiple pages for the organizational chart for Section 12 be considered and allowed, or are we limited to only a single page for the organizational chart for Section 11?
- A1. The organization chart for Section 12 is limited to a single page but can be printed on 11 x 17 and folded down to 8.5 x 11.

December 19, 2019:

- Q2. Can DOTD provide the following information?
1. Any engineering data or analysis for the project that was used to evaluate the existing bridge superstructure and substructure during the environmental process.
 2. The Line & Grade for the project as depicted in the environmental document.
 3. Any available geotechnical information.
- A2. Please see the Environmental Assessment link located under "SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED/ITEMS TO BE PROVIDED BY DOTD" on page 16 of the Advertisement.
- Q3. Will DOTD expand the list of Dynamic Traffic Assignment (DTA) models cited in "Minimum Personnel Requirement #10" to include Vissim and TransModeler?
- A3. A calibrated meso-scopic model using Dynameq has been completed for the project corridor.
- Q4. May the requirements of LAPELS be met by the time of the posting of the short list or contract execution?
- A4. No, all requirements of LAPELS must be met at the time the proposal is submitted as stated on page 1 of the advertisement.

- Q5. Does MPR No. 10 require a licensed professional engineer?
