Question and Answer

August 25, 2020:

- Q1. Section 19: Approach and Methodology, requires the consultant to provide a description of how the work will be performed and provide the proposed project schedule; however, since this advertisement is for an IDIQ contract, the projects are unknown at this time. How does a consultant respond to the requirements of this Section when the projects are unknown?
- A2. A consultant should review the scope of services in Attachment A to the advertisement to obtain a general understanding of what a typical task order would entail for the design of a DOTD safety project. Based upon that understanding, the consultant should provide a sample schedule that identifies the major milestones, deliverables, tasks, etc., to demonstrate sufficient understanding of a typical task order. The duration of the task order is not required.
