Questions and Answers

- Q. What system is currently being used to store/maintain the "DOTD Railroad Safety Inventory data"?
- A. DOTD is using Rail Inventory Management System (RIMS) now as it is compliant with the FRA inventory fields.
- Q. Will any newly implemented system be required to meet existing LA DOTD Rail Inventory Management System (RIMS) requirements? Is there a list of these existing functions/requirements and if so can you provide this list?
- A. This contract will have to be compliant with the FRA inventory field data, as is RIMS. There is not a complete list, other than the commitment to comply with the FRA inventory data.
- Q. How soon after NTP does the system have to be in place and operational?
- A. DOTD expects the consultant to be familiar with FRA inventory and to be able to interface with the FRA inventory at the start of the contract time or within a month of this initial date.
- Q. For Scope Item 12, does "directly to the FRA National Crossing Inventory Database" refer to using the FRA Grade Crossing Inventory System (GCIS) application programming interface (API)?
- A. Yes the API is preferred.
- Q. How often must the web based system update data within the FRA Grade Crossing Inventory Database?
- A. DOTD wants a minimum of monthly submissions to the FRA.
- Q. Will the new system be required to facilitate communication or collaboration with participating railroads?
- A. No.

- Q. Under the compensation section, does the \$251,525.00 cover the cost of the delivered and implemented web based data system as well as the other engineering safety support requirements?
- A. Yes, it covers the delivery and ongoing upkeep of the site & interface with FRA.
- Q. Could you explain the requirements/conditions for increasing this contract to the \$500,000 maximum compensation?
- A. The Advertisement has been revised to remove the \$500,000 maximum compensation. The \$251,525 covers the advertised scope of work.
