### **Question and Answer**

**May 6, 2021:**

- Q1. If a firm performs protective coating assessment services under this contract for the referenced state projects, will that firm be precluded from performing CE&I services for the referenced state projects?
- A1. **Yes; however, performing protective coating assessment services on the referenced state projects under this contract does not prevent the firm from performing CE&I services for state projects on other contracts.**
- Q2. May an individual who is in the process of receiving their la license be used to satisfy a MPR as long as their LA license is obtained prior to execution of the contract?
- A2. **No. All requirements of LAPELS must be met at the time the proposal is submitted.**
- Q3. In MPR No. 5, does the experience for structural design of approach spans and roadways have to pertain to a movable bridge project or can it pertain to a conventional design/fixed bridges?
- A3. **Experience with conventional design/fixed bridges is acceptable for approach spans and roadways.**
- Q4. In reference to MPR No. 5, please define roadway components relative to this requirement.
- A4. **Roadway components may consist of where the bridge abuts the roadway and some parking lot work.**
