Question and Answer

November 30, 2020:

- Q1. Attachment A – Scope of Services lists a Part I and Part III under Stage 3 Design, is there a Part II should be include?
- A1. There is no Part II. The typical work for Part II does not apply to these IDIQ contracts.

December 15, 2020:

- Q2. Per the advertisement, MPR No. 5 states “At least one (1) professional engineer, registered in the state of Louisiana, shall have a demonstrated experience in quality assurance for all engineering disciplines represented in the plans.” May this requirement be met with one engineer for each discipline identified in the RFP or is one engineer intended to meet the criteria for this MPR alone?
- A2. The requirement may be met by one professional engineer with demonstrated experience in QA for each discipline represented in the plans, or it may be met by a single professional engineer with demonstrated experience in QA for all disciplines represented in the plans.
- Q3. On page 20 of the IDIQ, the 4th requirement initially states that the responder must have at least (2) individuals, ONE of which must be registered in Louisiana, then lists under a. and b. that each must be registered in Louisiana, which seems to contradict itself. Please confirm that only one Louisiana professional engineer is required for this MPR and that the 2nd individual may be a registered professional engineer in another state at the time of the submittal.
- A3. The professional electrical engineers or engineer interns used to fulfill MPR No. 4a and MPR No. 4b must be registered in the State of Louisiana.
