Questions & Answers:

- 1. Research Approach Task 2: "It is anticipated that one span, all girders, will be painted with the recommended paint systems."
 - Does this mean the entire span from pier to pier is to be painted, or only a portion of the span's girders (enough to be representative for evaluation)?
 - Only the portion of the span needed to place the paint samples for evaluation.
- 2. Will DOTD forces be made available for rigging, surface preparation, and painting equipment and labor?
 - No; Due to the potential for schedule conflicts, the researcher needs to take the necessary steps to carry out these activities.
- 3. Will surface preparation be a project variable or are we limited by standard LADOTD practice?
 - The intent is to use the least costly surface preparation possible.
- 4. Is the LADOTD looking for a single generic coating system or state formulation?
