A1. There may be up to three (3) contracts awarded as a result of this advertisement. Pursuant to the “**PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS**” article of the advertisement, “If more than one (1) contract is to be selected based on this advertisement, no prime consultant is allowed to be a sub-consultant on any other consultant’s 24-102. If a prime consultant is submitted as a sub-consultant on another consultant’s 24-102, its proposal as a prime consultant may be deemed non-responsive.”
